
Pedagogical attention programme

Results after 18 year's experience

Introduction:

In 1994 a house to house study was carried out to find out the needs of people with congenital coagulopathies in Catalonia.

On a pedagogical level, the most significant data of the 89 families visited with under age children was:

- 39% expressed that their children had learning difficulties.
- 22% of pupils had repeated at least one school year.
- 12% had dropped out of school without obtaining a basic academic level.



Objectives:


To improve the academic and educational level of hemophiliac children and teenagers in Catalonia through the establishment of a pedagogical attention programme.


Description and methods:


The pedagogical attention programme was designed to attend these needs and the following projects were carried out:

- Concession of sociopedagogical grants to all the families.
- Assessment for teaching staff in all Catalonian schools which have a hemophiliac child or teenager.
- Setting up a monthly psychoeducative group of parents and another for children and teenagers.
- Personalized attention for children with specific educational needs: psychopedagogical diagnosis, back up classes, reeducation, curricular adaptation in coordination with schools, education and professional orientation, referrals to other professionals like psychologists or social workers, where necessary.









Prophilaxis treatment

Conclusions:

After 18 year's experience with this programme, we can affirm that we have been able to improve the academic and educational level of the hemophiliacs in Catalonia.

- Thanks to the grants, we can carry out a follow-up for each one of the 115 people who are currently studying.
- Of the 74 under age children, 10% have **learning difficulties**, all of whom are attended in a personalized way.
- 10% of students have repeated at least one school year.
- Only one teenager has dropped out before completing the minimum educational requirement.
- 41 people aged over 18 continue studying, 63% attend University.
