

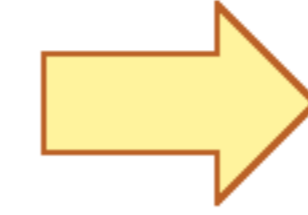
DEVELOPMENT OF AN EDUCATIONAL TOOL FOR HAEMOPHILIACS : ADVICES OF THE PHARMACIST

Haemophilia patients need a good knowledge of their disease and related-medication to **optimize** and **secure** self-management.



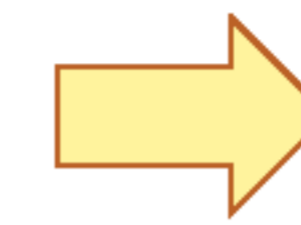
We created a brochure to give a **comprehensive** approach of the **mechanisms of the disease** and **how treatments work**.

This brochure was elaborated by a **multidisciplinary team** :

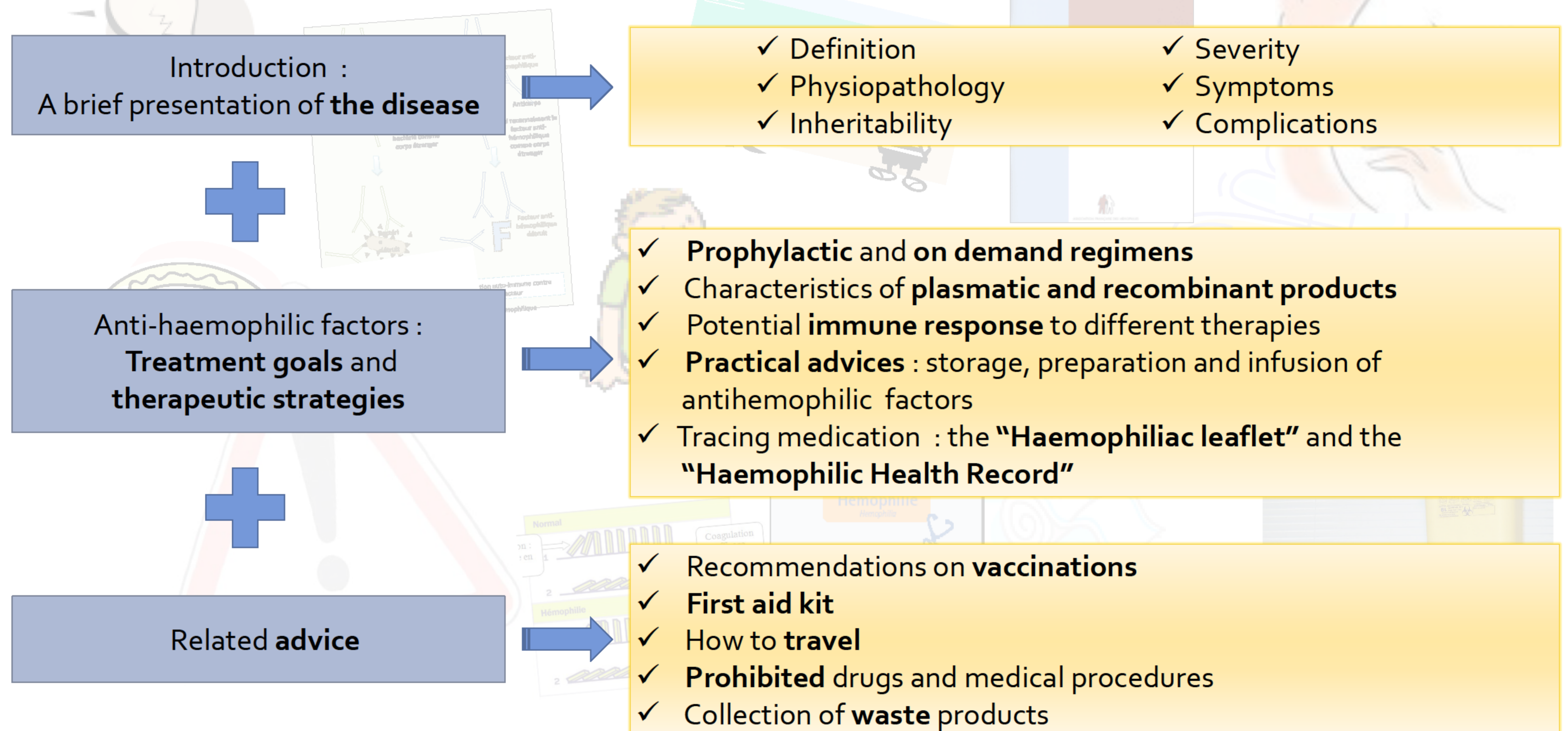
- pharmacists

The patients will find a list of **hospital pharmacies** that deliver blood clotting factors for home treatment and **Haemophilia Treatment Centres** corresponding addresses and phone numbers.

The brochure will be given by the pharmacist **during a dedicated talk**. We will evaluate its impact on patient's quality of life and understanding of treatment.

The brochure will be regularly **revised** and improved if necessary.
