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# Introduction and Objectives

After 9 years, the Hemoaction flashcards have been re-visited to ADD more information about Haemophilia and its different issues. IN-HEMOACTION brings new complex topics such as INHIBITORS, ITS TREATMENTS and several new cards.

> The objective is to do PSYCHOEDUCATION and deliver information in a playful and more simple way.



Psychoeducation empowers the patient and carers with early knowledge about the chronic condition, clarifies doubts about symptoms, helps to detect bleedings and treat faster.

#### Flashcards


are one of the several techniques used in psychoeducation which is a flexible and preventive intervention that several health care professionals can adopt in haemophilia treatments.

#### Methods

The renewed 30 pairs of flash cards come along with a short descriptive manual. They provide a logic sequence of information that can be used to explain a specific topic or to customize explanations depending on the patient's needs.

New topics related to haemophilia and its treatments are presented in 4 domains:


Vascular system and kind of bleedings



The clotting process and prophylaxis



Inhibitors and treatments



### Results

Regional workshops with families and health care professionals have been set to intro-duce and practice with the educational tool. By dividing the set of cards in domains, different professionals like nurses, physiothera-pists and haematologists for example, can approach the topic of their interest to explain easily the importance of prophylaxis, exercises or inhibitors and its treatments.

Gaining knowledge

and acceptance of haemophilia.

In our country, where literacy is an issue, flashcards are a useful approach to learn by using cognitive functions such as perception, comparison and memory. And if used also as an interactive game, motivation and joy can be part too of the learning process in children with haemophilia.



Physiotherapy and sport activities



Children from an early age, can start play Memory game and get familiarised with images that are fun, friendly and related to treatment. For example, different cards show Turtles symbolising slowness in clotting, carrying the Factor happily or helping in the Immune tolerance therapy.
